Threaded Flanges These flanges have internal taper threads and can be attached without welding, suitable for explosive or hazardous environments where welding is unsafe. Typically used in small-diameter pipes (up to 4 inches) for utility services. Slip-On and Socket Weld Flanges While not true pigtail flanges, these types are sometimes used in low-pressure systems where a long neck is not required.
