Residual Current Devices RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers) or RCDs monitor leakage currents and provide protection against electric shocks and insulation faults. They are usually rated at 30mA for domestic single-phase systems and are connected downstream of the main MCB. For enhanced protection, RCBOs combine overcurrent and residual current protection in a single device, protecting both the circuit and the user from faults.

Busbars and Wiring Considerations Inside the distribution box, busbars distribute power from the main switch to all branch breakers efficiently. Copper busbars or comb-type busbars are commonly used to ensure safe and balanced power distribution. Neutral and earth conductors are connected to separate bars to maintain safety and compliance with electrical standards.
