Depth and Height While width is critical for fitting equipment, depth and height also matter: Depth: Standard cabinets range from 600mm to 1200mm, depending on server chassis size and cable management needs. Height: Measured in U units (1U = 1.75 inches / 44.45mm), with common sizes like 42U or 48U for enterprise racks. Summary When selecting a network cabinet with a glass door, the internal mounting width is always 19 inches, but the overall cabinet width is typically 600mm or 800mm, depending on the size and intended use.
