A wire trough above a distribution box provides organized, protected routing for electrical cables while maintaining NEC-required clearances and accessibility. Purpose and Benefits A wire trough (also called a wireway or electrical trough) is a channel designed to house and protect electrical wires and cables. Installing a trough above a distribution box helps: Organize cables and prevent tangling or clutter Protect wires from mechanical damage, dust, and moisture Maintain accessibility for maintenance and future expansion Improve airflow around the panel, reducing overheating risks Ensure compliance with safety standards such as NEMA and UL . Wire troughs are typically made from steel, stainless steel, or non-metallic composites and feature removable or hinged covers for easy access . NEC Requirements and Clearances According to the National Electrical Code (NEC 2023): Working space in front of the panel must be at least 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high . Wireway depth beyond the front of the panelboard is limited to 6 inches, with the trough itself allowed up to 12 inches deep . No equipment or devices (except meters) may extend more than 6 inches beyond the panelboard . Panelboards must remain accessible, with no obstructions such as pipes, cabinets, or doors blocking the working space . Outdoor or wet locations require Type 3R wireways, while dry, exposed indoor locations can use standard wireways . Installation Considerations Mounting: Secure the trough firmly above the distribution box, ensuring it is aligned and level. Cable entry: Feed conductors into the trough after installation, keeping them organized and separated by type or voltage if necessary . Accessibility: Ensure covers are removable or hinged to allow easy inspection and maintenance. Environmental protection: For areas with moisture or dust, select a wireway rated for the specific conditions (e.g., dust-resistant or outdoor-rated troughs), . Expansion: Leave extra space in the trough for future cable additions to a...
