- Configure Wi-Fi:** Access the router's admin interface to set up SSID, password, and security settings. Enable features like Multi-Link Operation (MLO) or 4096-QAM if supported for optimal Wi-Fi 7 performance.
- Test the Connection:** Verify internet speed and coverage across devices. Adjust router placement to minimize interference and maximize signal strength.
