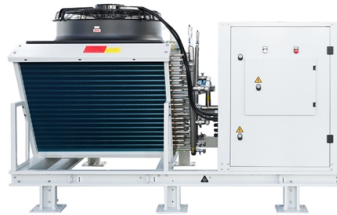


Wiring and Cable Tray Routing

Conduits: Choose from PVC, metal, flexible, or liquid-tight conduits depending on environmental conditions, cable type, and protection requirements. Conduits are often used where additional protection against dust, tampering, or mechanical damage is needed.

Installation Steps

Approval and Inspection: Obtain approval for shop drawings and materials. Inspect the site for accessibility, safety, and compliance with design specifications.

Marking and Identification: Clearly label each tray and conduit with feeder names and branch numbers to avoid confusion during installation.

Support and Mounting: Install support brackets at recommended intervals. Ladder trays typically require supports every 1.5–3 meters, depending on load and material. Conduits should be securely fastened to walls, ceilings, or trays.

Routing and Bending: Route cables along the planned pathway, avoiding sharp bends. Use appropriate fittings for changes in direction or elevation. Cable pits or junction boxes may be used at intervals for pulling and maintenance.

Grounding and Bonding: Ensure all trays and conduits are properly grounded. Flexible protective earthing conductors should connect all joints in metal...
