

Wiring method for secondary motor distribution box

Secondary motor distribution boxes should be wired using properly rated cables, mechanical compression lugs or split bolts, and follow grounding and code-compliant practices to ensure safety and reliability.

Motor Lead Connections Motor leads should be terminated using mechanical compression lugs (crimp or set-screw type) or split bolts, which provide secure and reliable connections between the motor and incoming power supply. Connections using only solder or twist-on wire nuts are not acceptable for industrial motors due to safety and reliability concerns (NFPA 79-2012, Section 13.5.9). Torque specifications for lugs and bolts must follow NEC recommendations to ensure proper clamping without damaging the conductors. Parallel motor leads should use lugs with the same number of barrels as the number of leads, and bolts should be torqued correctly. Belleville washers can be used when lug and bolt materials differ to maintain torque during thermal expansion.

Cable and Grounding Considerations Cables connecting the secondary distribution box to motors should be selected based on voltage, current rating, and environmental conditions. For variable speed drives, follow EMC and grounding guidelines to prevent interference and ensure personnel safety. Grounding should comply with local codes such as NFPA 70 (NEC) or the Canadian Electrical Code, and include proper bonding of the motor frame and distribution box. Keep secondary distribution cables or busways as short as possible to minimize voltage drop and fault currents. Use shielded or twisted-pair cables for variable frequency drives to reduce electromagnetic interference.
