Neutral Distribution: Neutral lines from the RCCB are connected to the neutral bus bar, which then distributes neutral to each MCB circuit. Earth Connection: The earth bus bar is connected to the building's earthing system, typically via an earth rod, and then distributed to all circuits. Circuit Wiring: Each MCB feeds the phase line to the respective lighting circuit, while neutral and earth lines are shared appropriately.
