Common in residential applications. Consists of one hot wire and one neutral wire. All circuit breakers connect to a single busbar, simplifying the layout and reducing space requirements.
- Three-Phase Systems**
Used in industrial or large commercial setups. Includes three hot wires (L1, L2, L3) and a neutral. Load balancing is critical: each phase should carry roughly equal loads to prevent overheating and system instability. Busbars are arranged to distribute power evenly across all phases.

Safety and Efficiency

Busbars reduce the risk of loose connections, short circuits, and overheating. Using pre-configured busbars allows for scalable and flexible installation, accommodating additional circuits without major rewiring. Protective covers on busbars prevent accidental contact and enhance safety.
