

Wiring of the distribution box socket with switch

Switches and sockets are wired from the distribution box using MCBs and RCCBs, with phase, neutral, and earth lines properly routed to ensure safety and independent control of loads.

Distribution Box Overview A distribution box (DB) is the central hub where the main power supply is divided into multiple circuits for switches, sockets, and appliances. It typically contains a main MCB, branch MCBs, and an RCCB for protection against overloads and earth faults. In single-phase domestic setups, the main MCB is usually a double-pole 63A device, while branch circuits use single-pole MCBs for individual loads ().

Wiring Switches For a basic switch controlling a lamp: The phase (live) wire from the distribution box is connected to one terminal of the switch. The other terminal of the switch is connected to the lamp. The neutral wire is directly connected to the lamp. The earth wire is not required for the lamp unless it has a metallic body (). Multiple switches can be wired in parallel for independent control of multiple lamps, ensuring each switch has its own phase connection ().

Wiring Sockets For a 3-pin socket: The phase wire is connected to the socket's phase terminal. The neutral wire is connected to the neutral terminal. The earth wire is connected to the earth terminal for safety. The socket wiring is usually taken directly from the distribution box rather than in parallel with other loads to maintain proper protection and load distribution (). For 2-pin sockets, the earth connection is optional if the appliance does not require grounding ().

Wiring Layout in the Distribution Box Incoming supply: Connect the phase and neutral to the main MCB. Branch circuits: Phase wires from the main MCB go to individual branch MCBs; neutral wires are connected to the neutral bus bar. RCCB: Connects phase and neutral lines to protect against earth leakage. Wire routing: Left side of the DB is typically used for incomin...
