

Wiring outgoing cables of the secondary distribution box

Cable Routing and Organization

Wiring direction: Typically, wiring between the main circuit breaker and branch circuits is on the left, while outgoing cables exit on the right (SMICO).

Binding: Use plastic ties to keep wires straight and organized, with uniform spacing to avoid tangling or mechanical stress.

Parallel connections: Can be used to simplify wiring and reduce difficulty when multiple outgoing feeders are involved.

Safety Measures

Ensure firm and secure connections at all terminals to prevent loose contacts, which can cause overheating or faults. Conduct a safety inspection after wiring to check for short circuits, overloads, or improper grounding. Use appropriate cable sizes and insulation ratings according to the system voltage and current requirements (HK Electric guidelines).
