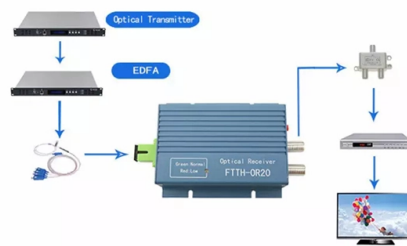

Use grounding conductors of appropriate material and size, and follow local electrical codes.

**Short-Circuit Protection:** Install circuit breakers or fuses rated for the expected load to prevent overheating and fire hazards . For PoE or other low-voltage circuits, ensure Class 2 or Class 3 power-limited protection is applied according to NEC Article 725 .

**Labeling and Safety:** Clearly label all circuits, switches, and terminals to indicate voltage, function, and operating instructions. Use dead-front panels to cover live parts, allowing only handles and indicators to be accessible, which improves safety and prevents accidental contact .
