

Wiring requirements for 380V distribution boxes

Outgoing Circuits: Each circuit breaker should be connected to the corresponding phase(s). For devices requiring 380V, connect any two phases, leaving the third phase without current if necessary.

Earth Connection: The protective earth wire should be securely connected to the distribution box enclosure to provide a safe path for fault currents.

Tightening and Securing: Use screw terminals to firmly secure all conductors, ensuring no loose connections that could cause overheating or arcing.

Safety Measures: Always cut off power before starting any wiring work. Verify that the system voltage matches the distribution box rating (380V three-phase, not 220V three-phase without neutral) to prevent equipment damage. Properly label all terminals and wires for easy identification during maintenance. Follow local electric...
