Connect the yellow fiber cable to the ONT's optical port, ensuring the connector is clean and properly seated to avoid signal loss. Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize. Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port. Power on the router and configure your network as needed.
